#### **Read Udaipur Read Bikaner**

The campaign was started in Bikaner and Udaipur in September 2008 with mobilizing non-paid volunteers from slums as well as schools and colleges. The targeted group was every child in 7-14 age groups who can not read.

By the end of October, 84 volunteers in Bikaner and 81 in Udaipur had been raised and trained to start accelerated learning classes in their areas.

In November, Pre test was conducted in 84 classes in Bikaner and 81 classes in Udaipur.

Pre tests showed the following picture -

In the month of December, post-test was carried out in the classes. Though we had not received good results and experiences of this campaign in Udaipur city, but in Bikaner, the results were encouraging. Now 40% of children can read a simple story and 46% can read word and letters.
