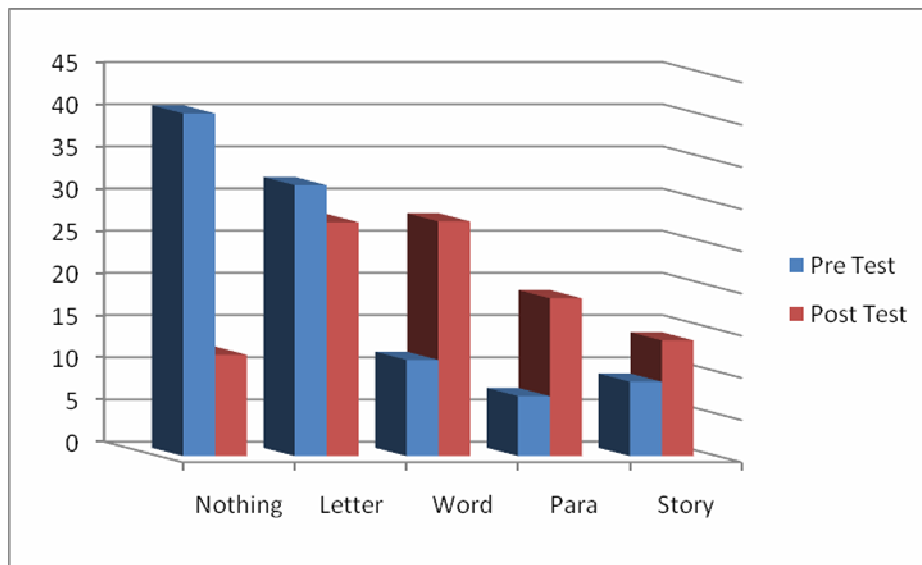


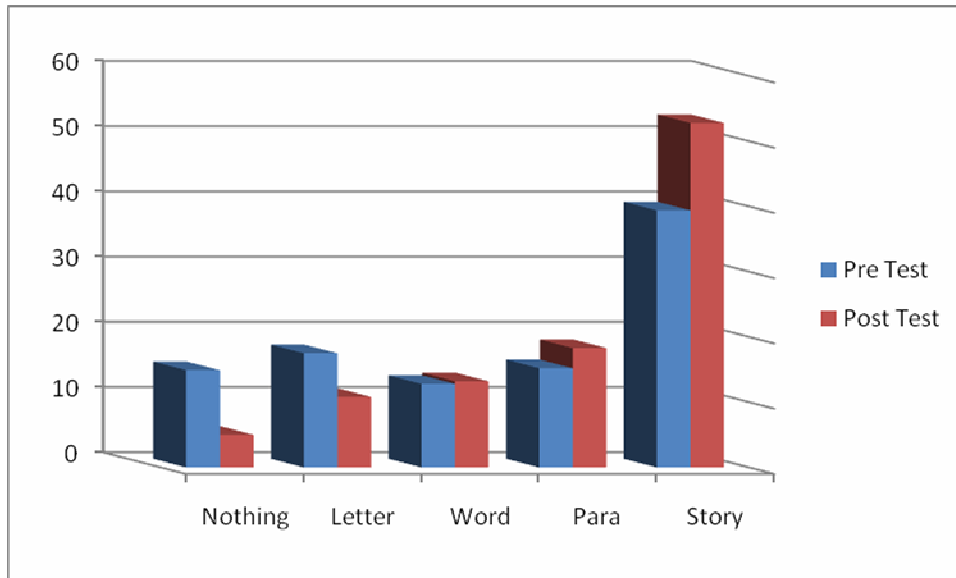
1. The Basti Library program conducted in Delhi in 2007-08.

The following graphs show the impact of the basti library program run in 301 bastis (communities) in 2007-08. A total of 63,324 children of 6 to 14 years of age group benefited from the program. The reading level of children of 6 to 7 and 8 to 10 years of age group were tested. The pre test was conducted in April 2007 and the post test in March 2008. It was observed that in the 6-7 year old age group, the percentage of children who read anything fell from 40% to 12%. Those who could read a word in the same age group increased from 11% to 28%. For the 8-10 year old age group, the percentage of children who could not read anything fell from 15% to 4%. Those who could read a story increased from 39% to 53%.

Comparative changes in reading levels of children aged 6-7 years in the Basti campaign in Delhi-0708.



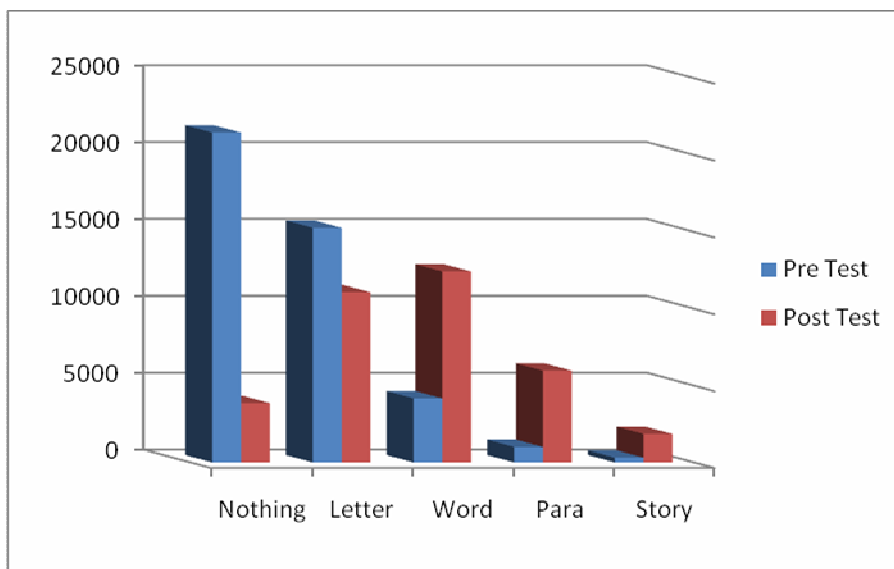
Comparative changes in reading levels of children aged 8-10 years in the Basti campaign in Delhi-0708.



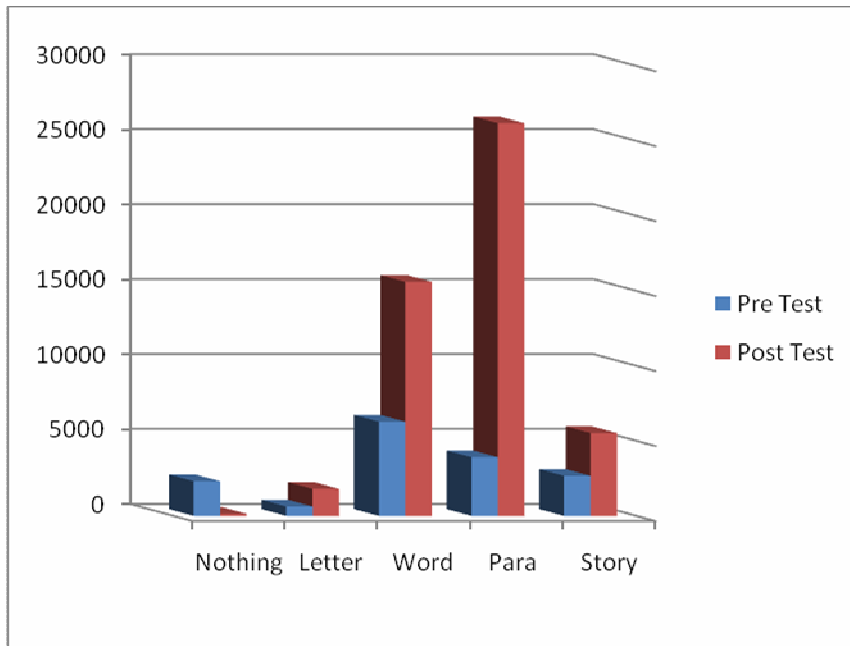
2. Read Mumbai program conducted in Mumbai from 2007-08

The following graphs show the reading improvements in children who were a part of the Read Mumbai program conducted in Mumbai in 2007-08. A total of 4227 children were tested in the pre test and 35712 children tested in the post test. The number of children who could not read anything declined from 21463 to 3854 and those who could read words increased from 4170 to 12423.

A total of 15814 children were tested for the pre test in Stds III,IV and V and 49257 were tested in the post test. The number of children who could not read anything declined from 2313 to 142 and those who could read a story increased from 2676 to 5521.
